On the day of the show the students must be in the gym in full costume by 8:00 a.m. Mass begins at 8:30 a.m. The performance begins at approximately 10:15 a.m. over on the Mission grounds and will run approximately one hour. Directly following your child's dance, parents must sign out their child from his/her teacher.

2010 St. Joseph's Day Costume Guidelines

St. Joseph's Day – Friday, March 19th

Below are the costume guidelines for St. Joseph's Day. Allow yourself enough time to acquire all the different pieces to the costumes. You may want to purchase, borrow, or sew all or part of your child's costume. ***Make sure your child tries on the entire costume before March 12 to ensure that it fits securely and will not hinder their dancing.***

KINDERGARTEN BOYS AND GIRLS: Brown Monk Costume to the ankle with hood and rope sash

1st BOYS AND GIRLS: Bird costume with headpiece, felt feet over tennis shoes, colorful tights or high socks

2ND -3RD GIRLS: Spanish style 3 tiered ankle-length dress, mantilla or lace for the hair (hair worn up in bun if possible), flower for hair, dress shoes with socks or tights

2ND – 3RD BOYS: Black dress pants, white long sleeved dress shirt, black vest, red sash at waist; pants and vest are trimmed in red or gold, dark dress shoes

4TH GIRLS: Spanish style 3 tiered dress or tiered skirt to ankle with peasant style blouse, shawl (secure with pin), flat sandals (no flip flops, must have strap around the back), hair worn in bun, hair sprayed grey (provided), broom (provided).

4TH BOYS: White pants, white long-sleeved dress shirt, poncho, white socks, sandals (no thongs, must have strap around the back), grey felt beard (provided), hair sprayed grey (provided), straw sombrero (provided), cane (provided),

5TH GIRLS: Green, white and red skirt to mid-calf (green at top – red at bottom), white bloomers (mandatory), white peasant blouse, ribbons (green, white & red) French-braided into hair, dress shoes (heel no higher than 2 inches/flats) with socks or nylons (optional).

5TH BOYS: White pants, white long-sleeved dress shirt, dress shoes, serape worn over left shoulder and pinned at waist on the right, jeweled sombrero (provided)

6TH GIRLS: Solid color peasant skirt to mid-calf, white peasant blouse, white bloomers (mandatory), coordinating sash, dress shoes/flats, nylons or tights (optional), coordinating ribbons French-braided into hair.

6TH BOYS: Same as 2nd/3rd grade; black gaucho style hat (provided)

7TH GIRLS: Same as 6th grade

7TH BOYS: Black dress pants, belt, white long-sleeved dress shirt, black hard sole dress shoes or cowboy boots, black bolo tie

8TH GIRLS: Folkloric Dress* (provided – **please submit a \$20 non-refundable rental fee made payable to MPS**), flesh colored tights, white bloomers (mandatory), black hard soled shoes with heel, hair worn in a low bun, no bangs, hair braid extension (provided), makeup o.k., jewelry o.k. (hoop earrings)

8TH BOYS: Black dress pants, white dress shirt, dress shoes, sash & tie (provided)

ROYAL COURT: Court costume will be provided (more information to follow) - **please submit a \$20 non-refundable rental fee made payable to MPS**

***Mrs. DeLain will issue the Folkloric dresses to the girls one week prior to the performance.** The girls will be measured and issued a dress that best matches her measurements. No color choices will be available. If you would like to purchase a custom made Folkloric dress to insure fit and color choice, please contact Marilyn Ibsen in the office.
