## Permission to Perform



It's that time of year again! Our St. Joseph's Day celebration will be on Saturday, March 15<sup>th</sup>. If you would like your child (grades K-8) to be a part of this historic day please complete this permission slip and return it by Friday, February 15<sup>th</sup>. Because the performance is on a Saturday please double-check your calendars to make sure your child does not have any conflicts on that day. The dances will be taught during the students' P.E. time.

On the day of the show the students must be in the gym in full costume by 8:00 a.m. Mass begins at 8:30 a.m. The performance begins at approximately 10:15 a.m. over on the Mission grounds and will run approximately one hour. Directly following your child's dance, parents must sign out their child from his/her teacher.

Please refer to the costume guideline sheet. Costumes are the responsibility of the parents to borrow, purchase or sew. No parents are to go into the school costume supply closets. If you plan to borrow a costume from the school supply you must contact Debra Hart in advance. Costumes are limited. If you want a particular color for your child do not assume that the school supply will have it. You may want to consider purchasing a costume.

## 2008 ST. JOSEPH'S DAY COSTUME GUIDELINES

St. Joseph's Day ~ Saturday, March 15, 2008

Below are the costume guidelines for St. Joseph's Day. Allow yourself enough time to acquire all the different pieces to the costumes. You may want to purchase, borrow, or sew all or part of your child's costume. Make sure your child tries on the entire costume before March 15 to ensure that it fits securely and will not hinder their dancing.

KINDERGARTEN BOYS AND GIRLS: Brown Monk Costume to the ankle with hood and rope sash

1<sup>ST</sup> BOYS AND GIRLS: Bird costume with headpiece, felt feet over tennis shoes, colorful tights or high socks.

2<sup>ND</sup>-3<sup>RD</sup> GIRLS: Spanish style 3 tiered ankle-length dress, mantilla or lace for the hair (hair worn up in bun if possible), flower for hair, dress shoes with socks or tights.

2<sup>ND</sup>-3<sup>RD</sup> BOYS: Black dress pants, white long sleeved dress shirt, black vest, red sash at waist; pants and vest are trimmed in red or gold, dark dress shoes.

4<sup>TH</sup> GIRLS: Spanish style 3 tiered dress or tiered skirt to ankle with peasant style blouse, shawl (secure with pin), flat sandals (no flip flops, must have strap around the back), hair worn in bun, hair sprayed grey (provided), broom (provided).

4<sup>TH</sup> BOYS: White pants, white long-sleeved dress shirt, poncho, straw sombrero (provided), cane, white socks, sandals (no thongs, must have strap around the back), grey felt beard (provided), hair sprayed grey (provided).

5<sup>TH</sup> GIRLS: Green, white and red skirt to mid-calf (green at top - red at bottom), white bloomers, white peasant blouse, ribbons (green, white & red) French-braided into hair, dress shoes (heel no higher than 2 inches) with socks or nylons.

5<sup>TH</sup> BOYS: White pants, white long-sleeved dress shirt, dress shoes, serape worn over left shoulder and pinned at waist on the right, jeweled sombrero (provided).

6<sup>TH</sup> GIRLS: Solid color peasant skirt to mid-calf, white peasant blouse, white bloomers, coordinating sash, dress shoes with nylons or tights, coordinating ribbons French-braided into hair.

6<sup>TH</sup> BOYS: Same as 2nd/3rd Grade; black gaucho style hat (provided).

7<sup>TH</sup> GIRLS: Same as 6th grade

7<sup>TH</sup> BOYS: Black dress pants, belt, white long-sleeved dress shirt, black hard sole dress shoes or cowboy boots, black bolo tie.

8<sup>TH</sup> GIRLS: Folkloric Dress\* (provided – please submit a \$20 non-refundable rental fee made payable to MPS), flesh colored tights, white bloomers, black hard soled shoes with heel, hair worn in a bun, no bangs, hair braid extension (provided), makeup ok, jewelry ok (hoop earrings).

8<sup>TH</sup> BOYS: Black dress pants, white dress shirt, dress shoes, sash (provided)

ROYAL COURT: Court costume will be issued (more information to follow)

\*Mrs. DeLain will issue the Folkloric dresses to the girls one week prior to the performance. The girls will be measured and issued a dress that best matches her measurements. No color choices will be available. If you would like to purchase a custom made Folkloric dress to insure fit and color choice, please contact Marilyn Ibsen in the school office.
