### Girls: \*

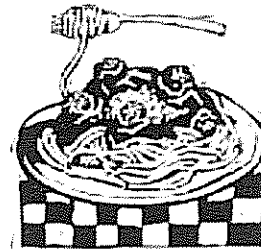
White peasant blouse tucked in  
Red/White/Green peasant skirt to mid calf  
Red or green sash tied at waist  
Shoe options (no socks are necessary)

Flats

Dress shoes with low heel

Sandals with back straps

Hair may be worn in any style (add red/white/green hair accessories - optional)



### Boys:

White pants\*  
Red waist sash  
Horizontal striped t-shirt (red/white or black/white)  
Shoe options

Dress shoes\* (no tennis shoes please)

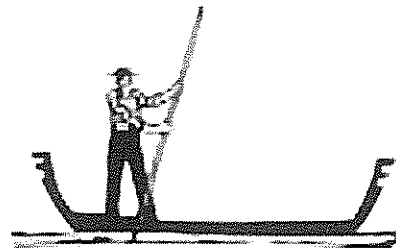
Sandals with back straps (no flip-flops)

Accessories (optional)

Color coordinating kerchief tied at neck

Straw hat with flat brim (gondolier style)

Moustache
